**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SEALED TENDER FOR DISPOSAL OF
CONFISCATED VEHICLES OF PARALAKHEMUNDI FOREST DIVISION**

1. The Divisional Forest Officer, Paralakhemundi Division invites sealed tender, from the intending purchasers (herein after called the tenders) quoting their offers for purchase of the confiscated vehicles on "as is where is basis", presently available at the location as mentioned against each in the tender notice enclosed herewith as Annexure-A. The sealed tender papers will be received **up to 12.00 P.M of 13th February-2023** in the office of the undersigned and will be **opened at 03.30,P.M.** of the same day in presence of all intending purchasers/bidders of their authorized representatives.
2. The intending purchasers are advised to obtain the tender forms along with terms and conditions from office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Paralakhemundi Forest Division on payment of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred) only which is non-refundable on any working days during the office hours **(11.00 AM to 05.30 PM)** from the date of publication of the tender notice up to **10th February-2023** . One application is required to be used for one vehicle.
3. The bidder may inspect the vehicle well in advance before submitting their tender paper.
4. Participation in the tender process and giving offer in the tender form shall be deemed as a proof that the bidder has inspected the vehicle and satisfied himself about it condition. Neither any complaint at later stage shall be entertained under any ground, what so ever after the tender is finalized. The department will not be held responsible for any dispute regarding the condition of the vehicle after the sale.
5. The tender forms should be filled up clearly and legibly in English or Odia language only. The offer quoted should be written both in figures and words. Correction and over writings if any should be attested by the bidder. The full name and complete postal address of the bidder should be clearly written in the tender paper. The tender paper without signature will be summarily rejected.
6. The bidder has to mention his PAN Number, GST Number on the paper and submits self attested photocopies of the same with the tender form. Self attested photocopy of the quarterly GST return of **March 2022** should also submit along with the tender form. The bidder should enclose a photocopy of the voter ID card/Aadhar Card/ PAN card as proof of his identity.
7. One individual may file tender for more than one vehicle. However for each vehicle there shall be individual tender paper. The registration no. of the vehicle sought to be tendered should be written in red ink on top right hand corner of the envelop.



8. The successful bidder shall have to pay security deposit which will be 25% of the bidding amount on the spot immediately after the announcement of the tender; this amount will be adjusted towards sale value. The bidder shall pay the balance 75% within 07 (seven) days from the date of issue orders of approval.
9. Taxes i.e. GST and Income tax with surcharges as per prevailing rate will be borne by the bidder/ purchaser on the sale value.
10. The successful bidder if fails to deposit the full sale value and the taxes levied thereof, with in the stipulated date line, the undersigned will be at liberty to forfeit the entire amount (including earnest money) deposited by the bidder to Government and the vehicle will be put to fresh sealed tender.
11. The successful bidder shall lift the vehicle from the storage place within 07 (seven) days from the date of full payment of bidding amount, failing which safe guard of the vehicle shall become of the responsibility of the bidder/ purchaser. No claim or complaint will be entrained. Thereafter the bidder will be charged the ground rent at the rate of 1% of the bidding/ negotiation amount per day or part of the day till remove of vehicles from the storage place. In case ground rent charged exceeds the sale price so deposited. The tender shall cease to have any right on the vehicle. The sale price so deposited will be adjusted towards rent and the vehicle will be deposited of by fresh sealed tender at the risk of bidder.
12. The vehicle shall not be delivered to the bidder unless and until full payment including taxes, if any is made and requisite formalities are complied with. The tools, implements and spare parts shall not be delivered with the vehicle.
13. If minimum price is not fetched by sealed tender, the DFO may dispose of the vehicle through negotiation at a price not less than the higher price offered by the bidder. Priority will be given to the highest bidder while the vehicle will dispose of through negotiation. If a vehicle put to tender sale with not fetch the upset price during tender process or negotiation, the vehicle will again put to fresh sealed tender.
14. The Divisional Forest Officer shall not handle any tax liability of the sold vehicle. The bidder is solely responsible for depositing of the Tax, insurance and fitness charges of the sold vehicle.
15. The Divisional Forest Officer reserves all the rights to accept or to reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof. The decision of the Divisional Forest Officer is final.
