Government of India seeks young persons to help, channelise their energies and capabilities towards nation building activities by organizing them into volunteers groups. You shall be asked to spearhead campaigns/ awareness programme about health, literacy, sanitation, gender and other social issues and may also be called upon to assist the administration in emergency or implementation of various programmes.

Eligibility:

- i) Education at least class 10th Pass (Class X)
- ii) Age **between 18 and 29 years, as on 1st April, 2023.**
- iii) No regular students are eligible for applying for NYC volunteership.


Honorarium:

Rs. 5000/- P.M. all inclusive for two years. This is neither a paid employment nor confers any legal right on the volunteer to claim employment with the Government.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Essential Qualification:-

1. Education qualification:- **Minimum class 10th Pass**
2. Age:- **Minimum 18years and maximum 29years as on 1st April 2023.**
3. Preference in selection will be given to the following:-
 - a. Candidates having higher educational qualification and knowledge of computer application.
 - b. Preferably, Candidates having the smart mobile phone and basic knowledge of operating different Apps pertaining to e- banking/ digidhan, social media etc.
 - c. Members of NYKS affiliated youth club.
4. Participation of weaker sections such as SC/ST community will be encouraged and gender balance amongst volunteer should be maintained to the extent possible.
5. Students who have enrolled themselves as a **regular students are not eligible for deployment** under the scheme, keeping in view of the nature of their full time assignment.
6. The volunteer who have earlier worked as NYCs and left in between before completion of their term or already completed their term are not eligible for selection again as NYCs.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The applicant should have Aadhar Card, Email ID and Mobile No for the purpose of future correspondence.
2. Age should be between **01st April 1994 to 31st March 2005** (Minimum 18 years and maximum 29 years as 01st April 2023).
3. After successful submission of online application form, a registration number is generated automatically and displayed on the screen which is to be used for getting the print out of filled in application form.
4. The applicant are required to bring the filled in application form along with all relevant documents in original as well as photocopy and two recent passport size photographs at the time of interview, if shortlisted.
5. Information regarding interview for selection will be informed by email and sms.

ABOUT THE SCHEME

1. National Youth Corps is a scheme of Ministry of youth affairs & Sports, Government of India. The NYC scheme is being implemented by NYKS.

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

1. The scheme of NYC would create a space enabling young men and women in the age group of **18 to 29** years to serve **up to two years** in National Building activities for which they would receive a **monthly honorarium of Rs. 5000/-**.

THE SCHEMES HAS FOLLOWING OBJECTIVES:-

1. To setup a group of disciplined and dedicated youth how have the inclination and sprit to engage in the task of National Building.
2. To facilitate the realization of Inclusive growth (both social and economic)
3. To act as modulators and peer group educators.
4. To act as role models for the younger cohort especially towards enhancement of public ethics, probity and dignity of labour.

ABOUT THE POSITION:-

1. **A total 16 volunteers shall be deployed** in the District. Two volunteers per block and two volunteers for computer/ documentation work are also deployed at Kendra Level.
2. It is clarified very categorically that if any candidate is deployed in between form among the waiting list, such deployment will be only for the rest of the period with in the financial year due to which the vacancy was created.
3. No volunteer in the case will be deployed beyond two years.
4. The deployment is purely on voluntary basis and hence the selected volunteers will not have any claim for regular appointments.

MONTHLY HONORARIUM:-

1. **Each volunteer will be paid a monthly honorarium of Rs. 5000/- after successful completion of monthly target, online reporting/ feedback and receipt of online attendance.**
2. The monthly honorarium of each volunteer will be credited to the concerned volunteer's bank account (SB account linked with his/her Aadhar Number) by e-banking/PFMS/DBT only.
3. The monthly honorarium of volunteers will be strictly calculated based on number of days they have actually worked (Excluding holidays) and for which online attendance is marked by the concerned District Youth Officer before 2nd day of the preceding month.
4. Each volunteer is required to link his or her bank account with Aadhar Number for enabling implementation of DBT (Direct Beneficiary Transfer System) PFMS as per Government of India guidelines.

5. If a volunteer is absent from his work, the monthly honorarium will be proportionately reduced without any notice, as per the online attendance submitted by the Kendra.

ROLE OF NYVS:-

1. Each NYV has a major role of catalic agent between youth clubs and development departments.
2. Each NYV has to prepare Youth profile of his/her block.
3. Each NYV is required to be IT Savvy. Further NYVs should have the capability of preparing report/documentation of youth program and upload online. NYC should also know about preparing reports for media/news statement. Each NYV should know the using of required mobile app (for example Digidhan, Digital India etc).
4. Formation of New Youth Club, Activation of defunct youth clubs in the major task of each volunteer.
5. Organizing NYKs regular and special programme with the help of youth clubs.
6. Guiding and motivating youth clubs members for involving themselves in community development programmes.
7. Recommending active/ dedicated members of youth clubs for involving themselves in community development programmes.
8. To maintain records of programmes conducted by youth club.
9. To submit regular reports/ online reports highlighting their work on regular basis.
10. Maintain liaison with development departments and youth work agencies in the block/district.
11. To attend meetings regularly at concerned Kendra & Block.

How to Apply:

1. Application must be submitted in online mode at the official website of NYKS i.e. www.nyks.nic.in.
2. Last date for submission of online application is **9th March 2023**.
3. Candidates are advised in their own interest to submit online applications much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability of failure of login to the website on account of heavy load on the website during the closing days.
4. The Sangathan will not be responsible for the candidates not being able to submit their applications within the last date on accounts of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the Sangathan.
5. Before submission of the online application, candidates must check that they have filled correct details in each field of the form. After submission of the online application form, no change/correction/modification will be allowed under any circumstances.
