**Subject: Engagement of Guest teachers against vacancies and outsourced staff in
EMRSs for the Academic Year 2026-27 – reg.**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the letters cited above, permission was granted to engage guest teachers against vacancies during the Academic Year 2025-26, alongwith the permission for engagement of outsourced personnel in EMRSs.

2. Further, NESTS has also permitted States to engage outsourced personnel and guest teachers till the onset of summer vacation during the Academic Year 2026-27 vide NESTS' letter Nos. NESTS/H-1/47/HRMiscellaneous/2024-25 dated 12/03/2026 and NESTS/NESTS-Circulars/129/2025-26 dated 09/04/2026.

3. In this regard, it is submitted that recruitment under EMRS Staff Selection Exam – 2026 is under process and is likely to be concluded soon. However, keeping in view that the Academic Session 2026-27 has already commenced, permission is hereby granted to engage guest teachers and other referred outsourced personnel strictly as per the guidelines cited above.

4. It shall be made sure that the engagement shall be made only for the Academic Session 2026-27 or till the posting of regular staff by NESTS, whichever is earlier.

5. An undertaking shall be taken from engaged outsourced personnel that

"The engagement is purely on outsource basis, and the engaged staff shall not claim any right to regularization of their service on account of this engagement."

6. An undertaking shall be taken from engaged guest teachers that

"The engagement is purely on adhoc basis, and the guest staff shall not claim any right to regularization of their services on account of this engagement."

7. All other terms & conditions of engagement shall be as per the extant guidelines already issued by NESTS in this regard.

(C) CTET

Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted by the Government of India.

CTET certificate issued on or before the cutoff date is essential.

Note:

For four year integrated graduation degree course with B. Ed Component, (B) is not necessary, however, at least 50% marks in all subjects individually and also in aggregate is mandatory.

Post wise elective subjects and Languages in the combination of subjects are as under:

a) **For TGT (Hindi):** Studied Hindi as an Elective/Main subject in all the three years of graduation (Under graduate course).

b) **For TGT (English):** Studied English as an Elective/Main subject in all the three years of graduation (Under graduate course).

c) **For TGT (Maths) -**

The candidates should have studied all the following three:

1. Mathematics as Elective / Main subject in all the three years of graduation (Under graduate course).
2. Physics at least 01 year / 02 semesters
3. One out of Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science, Statistics at least 01 year / 02 semesters

The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subjects are also eligible to apply.

Note: Candidates with B.Sc. (Hons.) in Physics or Chemistry are not eligible for the post of TGT (Maths).

d) For TGT (Science)-

Candidates should have studied Biology/Life Science/Botany/Zoology as Hons/Main Subject in all the three years of graduation (Under graduate course) with following combination of subjects for at least one year or 2 semester each

Studied any two subjects out of History, Geography, Economics and Political Science at graduation (Under graduate course) (3 years degree) level out of which one must be either History or Geography in all three years of graduation as an Elective/Main Subject and the second subject for at least one year / two semesters.

The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subjects are also eligible to apply.

a) TGT (Regional Language): Studied Concerned Regional Language as a subject/elective subject in all the three years of Degree course (Under

		graduate course). Note: Only in respect of TGT (Regional Language), degree in Education as approved by the State Government for Teachers post as on the cut off date of eligibility of ESSE 2025 is also allowed in lieu of B.Ed.
